Subject Area: World Languages

Course Name: AP (Advanced Placement) French (G&T)

Summary: The AP French Language Course is intended for students who wish to develop their proficiency in all four language skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Students who enroll must have a solid “B” average in French IV, teacher recommendation, and an advanced knowledge of the language and culture of French-speaking people. They should also have attained a reasonable proficiency in listening comprehension, speaking, reading, and writing. The reading, writing, and speaking assignments will be extensive and time consuming. (Students may take the AP French Language Examination.)
